Renée Streatfield is a Paediatric Nurse Practitioner with more than 30 years' experience supporting children with complex and life-limiting conditions and the whānau who care for them. Much of her work has focused on enabling families to safely manage care at home while reducing avoidable hospital admissions. After many years working in secondary care at Waikato Hospital, Renée moved into community practice, establishing a nurse-led clinic at True Colours Children's Health Trust in Hamilton.

Her Master's research explored the lived experiences of rural families caring for technology-dependent children, providing important insight into the challenges of accessing timely, coordinated healthcare outside major centres.

In this webinar, Renée will discuss the development and evolution of a nurse-led clinic designed to deliver specialist paediatric nursing care closer to home. She will explore how integrated, collaborative models can bridge the gap between primary and secondary care, improve access for rural communities, and reduce unnecessary emergency department presentations for tamariki with complex health needs.
